

CITY COMMISSION ROOM PIERRE, SOUTH DAKOTA June 28, 2022

The City of Pierre board of Commissioners met in regular session on June 28, 2022 with Commissioners Barringer, Huizenga, Todd Johnson and Vona Johnson present for roll call. Mayor Harding was absent. Commissioner Huizenga presided over the meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by an invocation. The agenda was approved as amended – Request to Bid 2023 Water Materials was removed. No one was present for public comment.

Commissioner Huizenga issued a proclamation for Park & Recreation Month of July.

Dave Houseman presented a request to close Church Street from Jefferson to Nicolette on August 13th from 8am to noon for the annual gravity drags. The event was moved from Governor's Drive last year due to construction and the new location was very successful with the most spectators they've ever had. They will use the SDDOT Parking Lot for staging and the adjacent blocks for the cars to drive around and cool off. The Street Department will provide barricades for the event staff to setup and staff will monitoring the Governor's Drive intersection. YMCA and Rawlin's Library will be accessed from the rear off Jefferson. Commissioner Vona Johnson moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to approve the street closure request on Church Street from Jefferson to Nicolette on August 13th from 8am to noon. Unanimous approval.

Cameron Howard, Airport Manager, presented the FAA Grant Application for the Runway 7-25 construction phase. The project includes reducing the runway from 150' to 100' and updating all lights and signs accordingly. The project estimate is \$7,506,000 and the grant comes with a 2.5% local match or approximately \$187,650. The project would be a 2023 construction and hopefully be completed by hunting season. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Barringer seconded to approve the request to apply for FAA funding for the Runway 7-25 Project and authorize the Mayor to sign all related documents. Unanimous approval.

Cameron Howard, Airport Manager, presented the Program Update for the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program. FAA requires it to be on-hand and updated every 3 years. The program allows for small business and minority business owners the opportunity to participate in construction contracts. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Vona Johnson seconded to approve the DBE Program Update. Unanimous approval.

Cameron Howard, Airport Manager, presented a request to purchase the ARFF Cart. This is a piece of equipment required by FAA for the testing of the foam discharge to contain within the cart and not be discharged on the ground. An FAA grant was previously awarded for this purchase with a 2.5% local match. The quote is for \$28,594.43, leaving \$714.86 City participation. Commissioner Huizenga moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to approve the purchase of the ARFF cart for \$28,594.43. Unanimous approval.

Twila Hight, Finance Officer, presented the request to surplus property from the Library. The items will be listed on a Library list-serve for other Library's to purchase. Commissioner Vona Johnson moved and Commissioner Barringer seconded to approve the request to surplus Library property as presented. Unanimous approval.

Commissioner Barringer moved and Commissioner Todd Johnson seconded to adjourn. 6:06 p.m. Unanimous approval.
